

# Relaxing gingerbread-man is hot chocolate -crochet pattern-

Inspired by the Christmas spirit, I thought I'd combine two of my favourites: gingerbread and hot chocolate. This little gingerbread man in hot-chocolate is great for a Christmas tree ornament on a bit larger Christmas tree, but also cozy as a table decoration.

I am writing the pattern elements in the order in which they should be made.

I wish you a Merry Christmas!

I wrote the pattern in US terminology.

**Yarn:** Catania Original red (115), white (106), chocolate brown (162), terracotta brown (426)

**Hook size:** 2 mm

**Others:** poly-filling, 2 piece 5 mm safety-eyes.

**Its width and height:** 8 cm

## Rövidítések:

ch – chain

sc – single stitch

slst – slip stitch

dec – decrease

inc – increase

hdc – half double crochet

MR – magic ring

BLO – back loops only

FLO – front loops only

F.o. – fasten off



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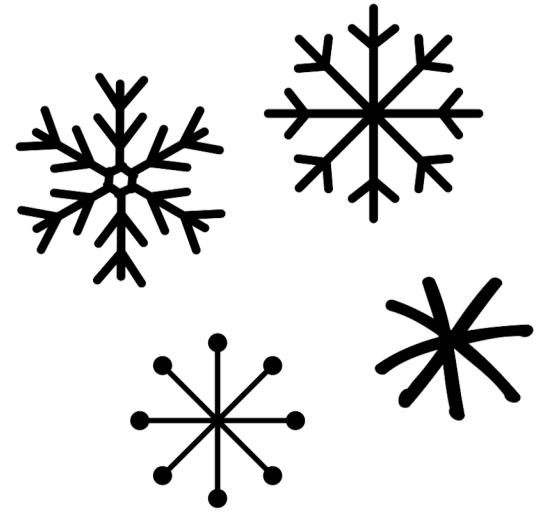
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## Mug - start with red yarn

- 1.) MR-be 6 sc (8)
  - 2.) inc (16)
  - 3.) 1 sc, inc (24)
  - 4.) inc, 2 sc (32)
  - 5.) 3 sc, inc (40)
  - 6.) inc, 4 sc (48)
  - 7.) BLO sc (48)
  - 8-9-10-11-12-13.): sc (48)
  - 14.) 3 ch, skip 3 sc, (this will be the bottom attachment point for the mug's lug later), sc (48)
  - 15-16-17-18.) sc. (48) The last sc of the 18. row, change color to chocolate brown.
- Before continuing, embroider the snowflake patterns on the side of the mug with white thread, so we can sew it inside.
- 19.) BROWN: BLO 4 sc, dec (40)
  - 20.) 3 sc, dec (32)
  - 21.) 2 sc, dec (24) Stuffed.
  - 22.) 1 sc, dec (16)
  - 23.) dec (8), Cut a 15 cm thread and tighten the hole.



## Pirossal polytatjuk a bögre oldalát:

Slip knot and crochet single stitches around the edge of the mug over 3 rows. This way, next to the cocoa, the small mug will have a high rim. For the last one, slst in the next st and f.o

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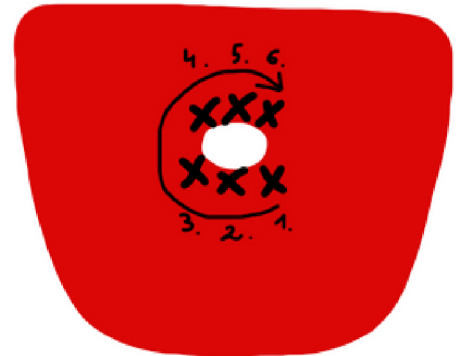
## The cup's ear - with red yarn

crochet into the lower right st of the hole on the mug and crochet around clockwise, as you can see in the picture.

1.) 6 sc around (6)

2-10.) (9 row) sc (6)

Cut 20 cm of thread and sew it to the mug.



## Marshmallow (2x) - with white yarn

1.) MR with 6 sc

2.) BLO sc (6)

3. sc (6)

Cut a 20 cm thread and tighten the hole by sewing it into the BLO. We don't stuff it. We sew these onto the cocoa as we like!

## Gingerbread man - with terracotta yarn

1.) MR with 6 sc (6)

2.) inc (12)

3.) 1 sc, inc (18)

4.) 2 sc, inc (24)

5-6-7.) sc (24)

8.) 2 sc, dec (18)

9.) 1 sc, dec (12)

At this point, insert the 2 safety eyes between rows 5-6 at a distance of 6 sc and sew up the mouth with white thread. We stuff the head.

10.) sc (12)

11. 1 sc, inc (18)

12-13-14-15.) sc (18)

Optional: Sew two button onto the body using the "french knot" embroidery technique. Cut 25 cm of yarn, stuff it, then sew the bottom together.



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## Gingerbread man's hands 2x - with terracotta yarn

1.) MR with 6 sc (6)

2-3-4) sc (6)

We don't stuff it, cut a 15 cm thread, and sew it onto the body in line with the neck.

You are now done with this cute little figure.

If you want to use it as a Christmas tree decoration, I recommend that you crochet a hanger made of chain links with red yarn to the edge of the mug.
